Using MDS Data to Identify Abuse of Antipsychotic Medications in Nursing Facilities

On **Thursday, May 4, 2023 from 3:00-4:00 pm ET**, the State Data Resource Center (SDRC) will outline approaches using available CMS Minimum Data Set 3.0 (MDS) data in combination with Medicare Parts A, B, and D data to identify inappropriate use of antipsychotic medications and related diagnoses (e.g., schizophrenia) in nursing facilities for dually eligible individuals.

SDRC staff will provide related background information, review the Medicare datasets, and outline the analytical approach Medicaid agencies can take to perform this type of anti-fraud, waste, and abuse investigation. A brief Q & A session will follow the presentation. The intended audience for this webinar is: (1) Medicaid personnel working with Medicare and/or Medicaid data for dually eligible individuals, and (2) Medicaid personnel involved in program integrity efforts for the dually eligible population.
